## Additional Product Instructions \& Illustrations Dritz ${ }^{\circledR}$ : $12^{\prime \prime}$ Specialty Ruler (item \#44088)



## What is it?

It is a lightweight aluminum ruler, designed with an extra $1 / 4$ " at each end to ensure accurate 1" and 12 " measuring. Each side is different, with SIDE ONE offering both inch marks and centimeter markings as well as holes to create circles. SIDE TWO includes inch and $15^{\circ}$ incremental angle markings - great for foundation quilting, paper piecing, general pattern making, crafts, and home decor projects.

## How do you use it?

- On SIDE ONE, use the small holes located below inch marks to easily and accurately draw full-inch circles (example: 2") with a fine-tip pen, mechanical pencil or fine-tip awl.
- On SIDE ONE, use the eight holes located between 0 and $7 / 8$ " to draw circles with a fractional radius (example: 2-3/4").
- On SIDE TWO, use the $15^{\circ}$ incremental angle markings, that fan out from the lower left corner, to draw angles. These are great for quilting and other small design shapes.
- On SIDE TWO, there are inch marks with both $1 / 4$ " and $1 / 2$ " increments.
