


# How to use Belt Tips

## What is a Belt Tip?

It is a metal cap designed to encase the ends of 1-inch wide webbing, belting, strapping, ribbon and fabric for a finished appearance. It also prevents wear and raveling on the ends of these woven products. Two sets of tips are included. Construction is so quick and easy, you can create more than one belt strap to exchange with the same buckle. A new belt every day!




## How do you use a Belt Tip?

1. Cut belting to desired size. Use scissors to trim the end so it is slightly rounded. Seal raw edges with Fray Check<sup>®</sup>.

2. Insert end of belting into metal tip, making sure edges are even and ends are fully inserted into tip.

3. Use pliers to gently flatten the middle and sides of the tip together. Teeth should extend into the belting. Check to make sure belting is secure..



**TIP: Place a scrap of fabric over the tip when using pliers to avoid scratching the metal.**

4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for opposite end of belt strap.
