

### How to Attach Campaign Hardware

Embellish and transform your furniture. Campaign hardware is great for garage sale finds and upcycling! Use individually in each corner, or group for stunning, artistic embellishment. Position L-corners at the straight edge of the quatrefoil corners to create a larger design unit for added impact. Use right-angle corners to reinforce construction and emphasize design.


Templates follow at 100% size for easy design placement. Mix and match!







## How to Attach Campaign Hardware (continued)

The campaign hardware has been grouped on the next few pages to show the coordinating finishes and textures. Group them or use them separately for stunning effects.







Style 44789-65, 3.125" Nickel Campaign Corners




Style 44799-65, 2.625" Nickel Quatrefoil Corners




Style 44795-65, 3.125" Nickel Campaign Corners



Style 44793-35, 2.625" Brass Quatrefoil Corners










RIGHT-ANGLE CORNERS: Right-angle corners come in two sizes: 2" x 2" and 3.15" x 3.15". Matching nails are included. Combine these with quatrefoil and L-corners to upcycle and redesign furniture.






## How to Attach Campaign Hardware (continued)

RIGHT-ANGLE CORNERS: Available colors and finishes for the 3.15" x 3.15" corners are shown below. Mix and match with quatrefoil and L-corners for stunning results!






L-CORNERS and QUATREFOILS: Use the templates provided to design your campaign hardware arrangement. When you've made the final design decision and have the actual metal pieces in hand, tape them to the project. Use a measuring device to obtain the most accurate placement and to ensure that the placement of all corners aligns.



Mark each hole position with an awl. To do this, hold the tip of the awl in the metal hole and hit it with a mallet. The indentation made by the tip of the awl forms a pilot hole to enable you to accurately position the tip of the nail.

#### FAO

What is a pilot hole? It is a starter hole, used to secure the tip of a nail or screw so that it can be quickly applied. It is usually made with a drill, and is always smaller than the nails to be used in the project. Because the nails required for the campaign hardware are so tiny, we recommend an awl instead of a drill to make the pilot hole.






L-CORNERS and QUATREFOILS (continued):

3. Place the tip of the nail into the pilot hole. Use a mallet to softly tap the nails into place.

#### TIP

To prevent bent or dropped nails, use needle-nose pliers or forceps to hold the nail in place while starting to hammer.





### How to Attach Campaign Hardware (continued)


RIGHT-ANGLE CORNERS:

• Choose the placement for your corners. When you've made the final design decision and have the actual metal corners in hand, tape them to the project. Use a measuring device to obtain the most accurate placement and to ensure that all corners align. Mark each hole position with an awl. To do this, hold the tip of the awl in the metal hole and hit it with a mallet. The indentation made by the tip of the awl forms a pilot hole to enable you to accurately position the tip of the nail.








### Suggested designs - Quatrefoil

### Suggested designs – L-Corners

We have grouped the corner hardware at 100% size into additional configurations. To use these as templates, make multiple copies of this page. Then cut out the designs and tape to your furniture in the desired placement. Group corners to create a focal point at the center of your piece of furniture. Or position in a row to form an energetic directional design.

Read the entire tutorial for information on how to attach each piece. *Always* use actual hardware to mark nail positions and make pilot holes.
