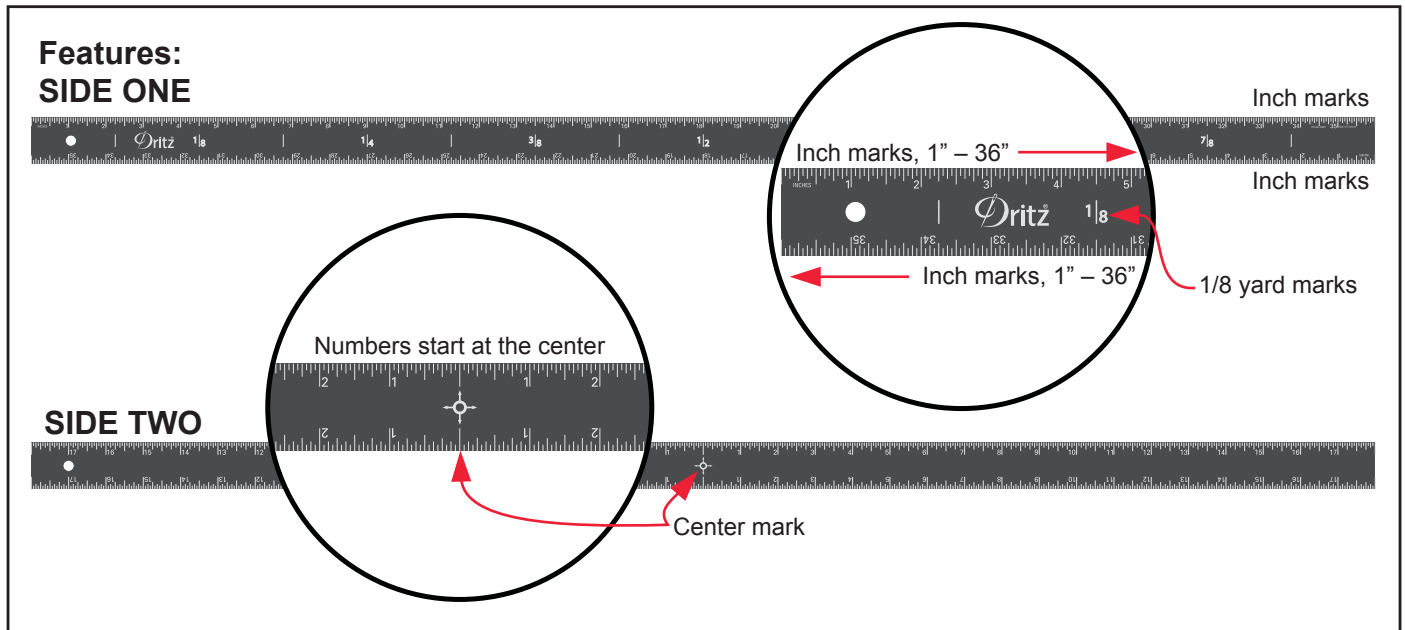




## Additional Product Instructions & Illustrations

### Dritz®: Anodized Aluminum Straight Edge (item #44087)



### What is it?

As the name implies this is a straight edge, for use in cutting, making perfect straight lines, painting and a myriad of other household projects. At 36" long, it is great to use when measuring lengths of fabric or to measure the distance from the ceiling to the top of your window. It offers standard inch marks, plus a centering mark on side two.

### How do you use it?

- On SIDE ONE, numbers start at opposite ends, so you always have the starting point in the correct place.
- On SIDE ONE, use the eight-yard marks, located every 4-1/2", as a quick reference when measuring something that must be converted to yardage. No math required.
- On SIDE TWO, use the centering feature for measuring curtains when applying drapery hooks or grommets, or when centering an appliqué on a fashion garment. The numbers start at the center and work to each end. Easy to use!
