

How to Attach a Leather Label

What is a Leather Label?

It is a small piece of genuine leather with a unique word or phrase stamped into its surface. One hole on each end enables you to hand stitch the label to a project; you may also attach them with small rivets—items #750-65,750-38 or 750-33 and rivet tools #750T, designed with this purpose in mind. Labels announce that you have hand made your project with love and it is one of a kind!





How do you attach a Leather Label?

1. Plan position.

Label can be attached before or after the project is constructed. Keep in mind that if you use rivets, the project material must be flat while applying. It may be easiest to attach the label before the project is completed.

2. Attach to project. Use one of the following methods:

Hand Stitch: Hold the label in place with fingers. Stitch through the holes, using a hand-sewing needle and thread or floss. A few stitches through each hole is all that is required.

<u>Rivets:</u> Attach with rivets and rivet hand tools following package instructions.
