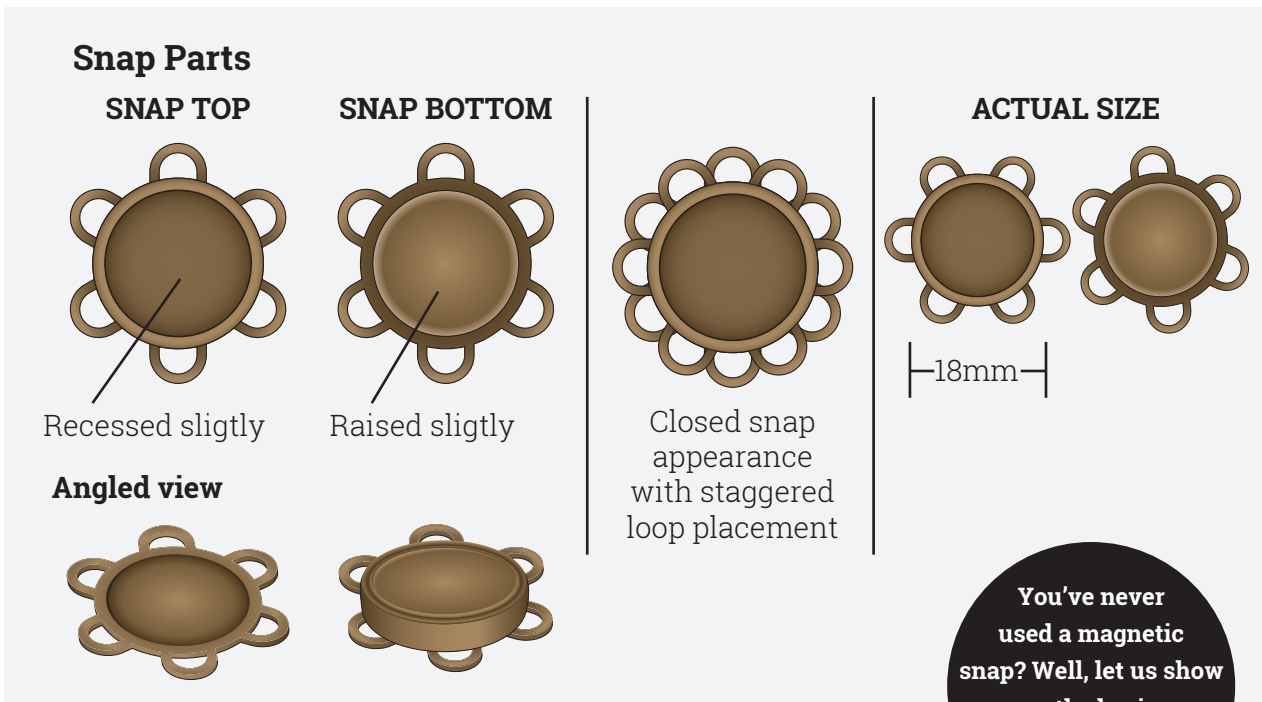


# How to Apply a Decorative Sew-On Magnetic Snap

**This Dritz® Sew-On Magnetic Snap is not only a functional closure, it is a decorative flower shape. Show it off – don't hide it!** Use it for the top opening and the side flaps on purses, bags and totes. Add it to store-bought bags or ones created from scratch. It is applied on top of the fabric (not inside the fabric, like other magnetic snaps), so sew it on with a fun thread color. Make a statement – your functioning snap is as pretty as a flower!

You will need:

- 1 set of magnetic snaps
- Marking pencil
- Hand-sewing needle
- Matching or contrasting thread
- Your project
- Optional: Iron-on interfacing

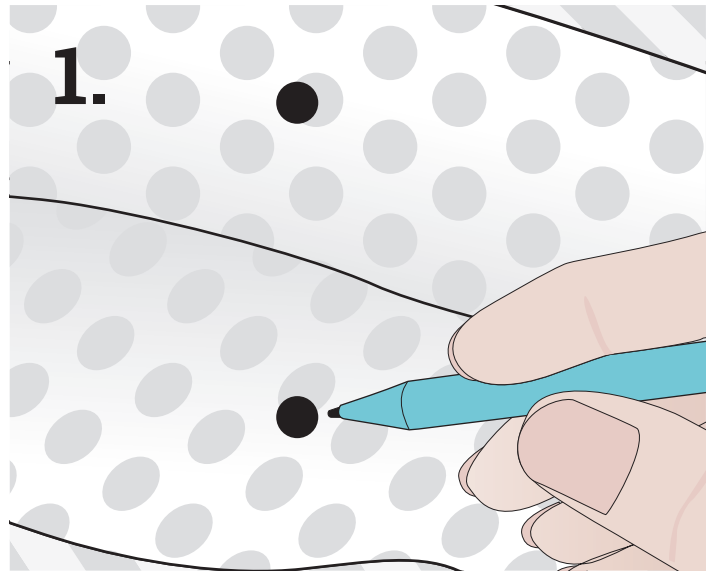

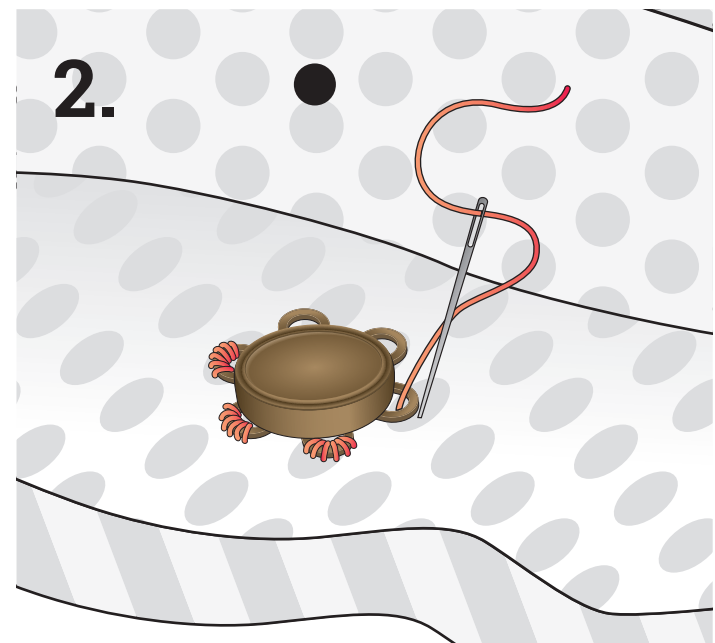


# How to Apply a Decorative Sew-On Magnetic Snap

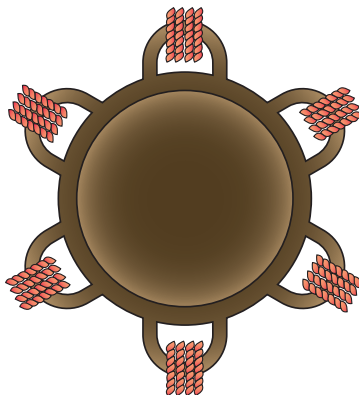
1. Measure and mark the desired position for the snap on both sides or layers of your project.



2. Center one side of the snap over the first mark and hand sew in place.

# How to Apply a Decorative Sew-On Magnetic Snap

3. Position the other side of the snap over the opposite mark and hold it in place. Carefully close the snap to check for correct placement and position. Unsnap and sew the second side of the snap in position.
