

How to Use a Sweater Comb

What is a Sweater Comb?

It is a small hand-held device used to de-pill napped, woven or knitted materials such as sweaters. At the end of sweater season sweaters can look pretty tatty. Remove fuzz easily and quickly with a sweater comb. Coats, blankets and other items can have an extended life when the pills are removed. This comb is also great for travel!

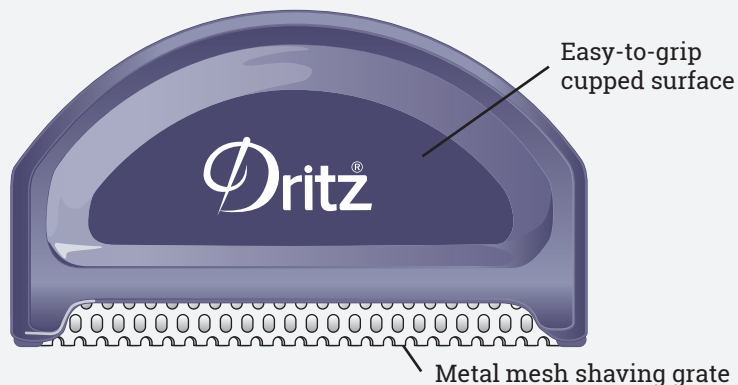

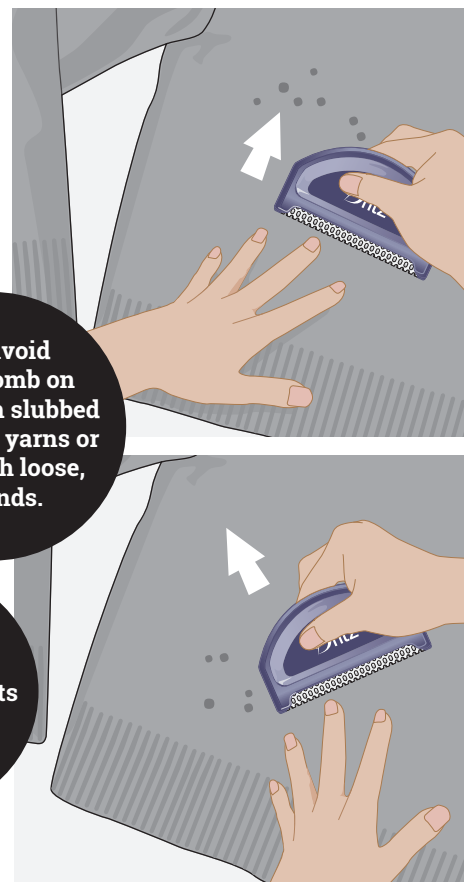

How do you use a Sweater Comb?

1. Place item on a padded surface such as an ironing board.
2. Hold fabric taut with one hand. With tool in the other hand, use short swipes, moving away from the hand securing the fabric.
3. Always remove fuzz from comb as you go.
4. On heavily pillied items, change directions often. Loosen fuzz in one direction; clean the comb. Then gently move tool in opposite or diagonal direction to pull up more fuzz. Repeat each direction change with less pressure for hard-to-remove pills. Move only one direction at a time; do not rub comb back and forth or 'scrub' the fabric.



TIP: Avoid using comb on items with slubbed or looping yarns or knits with loose, cut ends.

TIP: Use less pressure on lightweight knits to avoid stretching.
